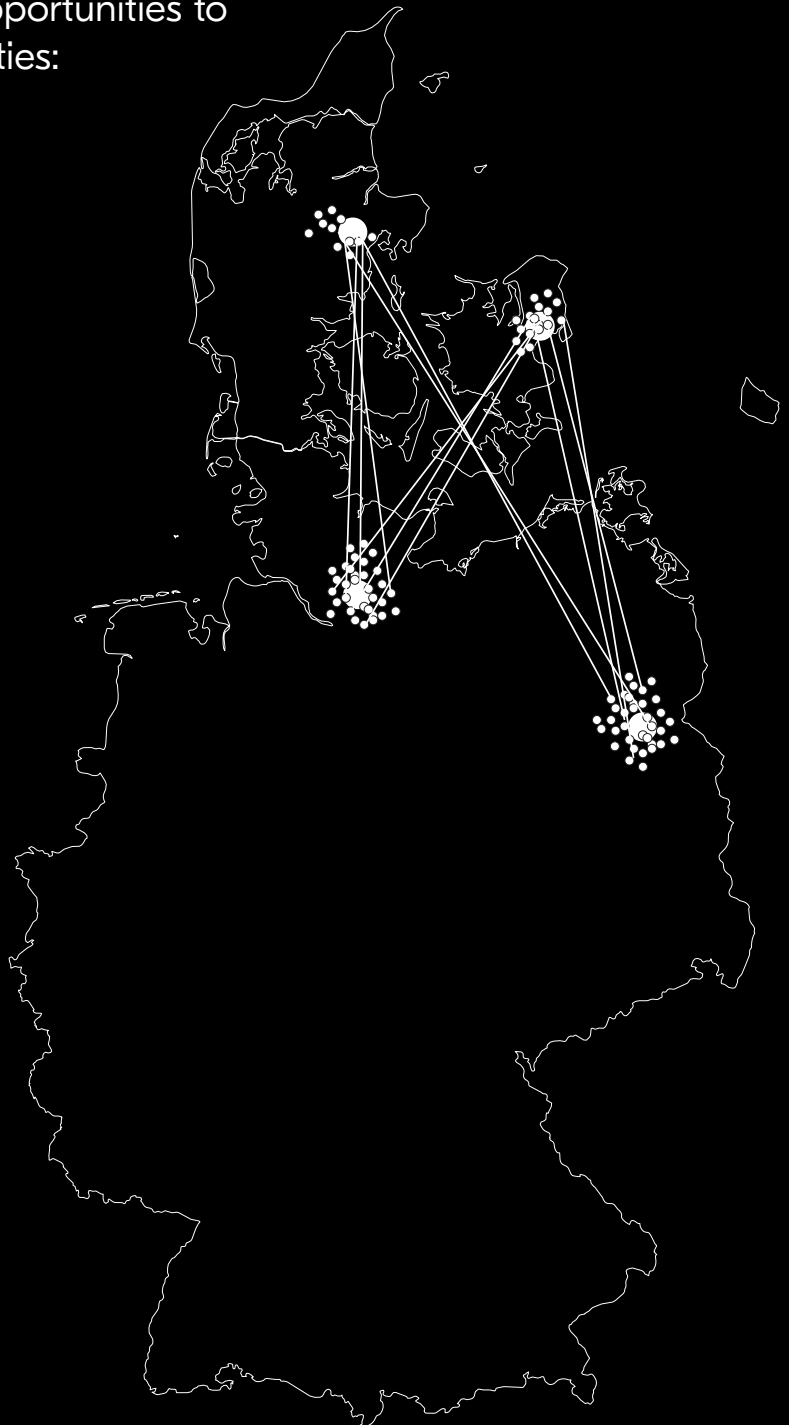


NEW DANISH MUSIC INITIATIVE IS OPEN FOR PARTNERS

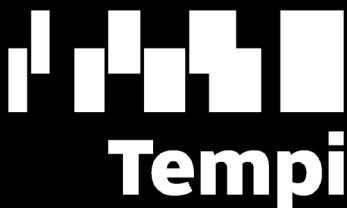
